

## Payment Deadline for college credit from College Credit Now or Willamette Promise: March 6, 2020

### College Credit Now through Chemeketa Community College

To become a College Credit Now student you will need to first complete the admission application <https://www.chemeketa.edu/programs-classes/high-school-programs/college-credit-now/>

Once your application is processed and you have received the welcome email containing your login information you can then register for your College Credit Now course through *My Chemeketa* <https://login.chemeketa.edu/idp/AuthnEngine#/authn>

College credit will only be applied when a student has registered, received their "K" number and paid the bookkeeper \$30.00. This is a one-time annual fee, a student can take any college credit classes that are available at their school.

If you are unable to cover the additional cost of College Credit Now classes, contact the bookkeeper to find out about resources that are available through your school. **TO RECEIVE CREDIT THE PAYMENT MUST BE MADE BY 3-6-20.**

### Willamette Promise (WOU/OIT) credit classes

To become a Willamette Promise student, you will need to talk with the high school college course teacher to opt in for college credit. The next step will be to visit the Willamette Promise website <https://www.wesd.org/> click on the "Accelerated Credit" tab at the top of the screen and follow instructions. This is a one-time annual fee of \$30.00, a student can take any college credit classes that are available at their school.

To pay for the college credit you need to click on "Pay Student Fees". Credit or debit cards as well as Pay Pal are accepted. Retain the confirmation email you will receive for your records.

If you are unable to cover the cost of Willamette Promise classes, click on the "Fee Waiver" link on the Student Fees page. **TO RECEIVE CREDIT THE PAYMENT MUST BE MADE BY March 6, 2020.**

3. Click on Schedule Change Request
4. Completely fill out the electronic request form
5. Request are answered in the order they are received. Not all requests will be honored. Students will receive an e-mail with the outcome of their request once it has been processed, check your email (junk email also). Schedules will not be changed to accommodate teacher or class period requests.

**Last day to request a semester 2 schedule change is Thursday, January 23 by 12:00 a.m. (midnight)**
