

Senior Photo Information

Deadline for Senior Photos: Friday, November 3rd

Picture specifications: All photos should feature the student from mid-chest and up, and we prefer a close-up of the face. Please do not submit photos with props (e.g. sporting equipment) or animals (e.g. your horse or your dog). All photos must be school appropriate. If a photo is rejected for any reason, the student and/or parent will be contacted to submit a new photograph. If a new photograph is not submitted by the publication deadline, the student's Dorian (ID card) photo will be used in place of a submitted senior photograph.

Submission: We prefer that all photographs be submitted electronically. Our first preference is for you to email the photograph. Please email it to **titanseniopics@gmail.com**. Keep in mind that online submission allows you to submit a higher resolution photograph, making your photo in the yearbook that much clearer. As a last resort, paper copies of photographs may be submitted in an envelope, marked with the student name, and given to the front office for the yearbook staff. A paper copy of a senior photo should be 2x3 inches or a standard size wallet.

Senior Ad Photos: If a parent or photographer would like to submit photographs for senior ads, they may do so through the online submission process indicated above. When tagging the photo, please tag it as "Senior Ad" and then include the student's full name.
