GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To be able to participate in the graduation ceremony: Seniors must meet the 24 credit requirement, complete the PEP and have passed the Essential Skills in reading, writing and math. All seniors have met the career related learning experiences and extended application requirements through their courses they have completed. For Seniors to be able to walk at graduation, they need to have passed their Senior Advisory, or successfully completed the alternative requirement that is given by the Principal. Any additional coursework, such as online, college credit, work experience credit or District Alternative Education credit, must be completed and submitted by 3:00 p.m. on June 3, so that credits can be verified.
